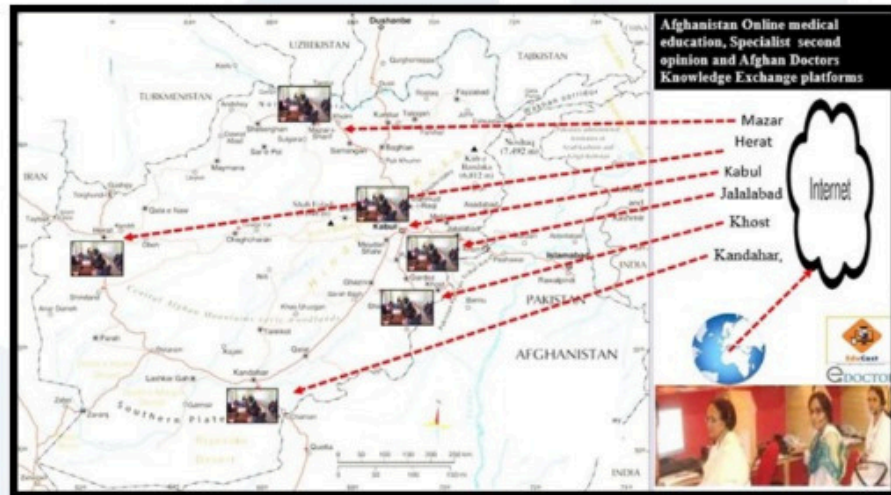

Through its own funding established a Tele center at Kabul Shefajo Hospital with support from Dr. Najmasama Shefajo-President of Afghanistan Society of Obstetrics and Gynecology. eDoctor from 12 International locations were supporting the Teleconsultation efforts at this facility.

2019 Pakistan – EDUCAST wins a grant, by Transform Fund, under the Islamic Development Bank's Science and Technology department, in its global challenge fund.

“Creating a Home based out of practice Lady Doctors Tele-Health network by training them in Maternal and Newborn Mortality prevention through use of Innovative eHealth platform”

Resulting bringing back of a total 1,500 plus Female doctors – out of the existing 25,000 Pakistani out of practice Female doctors inside Pakistan and world wide.



- 1) Govt/Parents spend PKR 7.5 mil on these doctors in education and initial house job (5 Years +1 Year);
- 2) By bringing back them into National Health services through retraining, an investment amounting to PKR 11.00 Billion has been recovered.
- 3) They have played a critical role in handling 450,000 COVID 19 home-isolated patients in Sindh Province, jointly with Govt of Sindh during the 2021-2022 Covid pandemic.
- 4) This IsDB-supported "eDoctor" project is playing a key role in offering telehealth support for Mother & Child care in currently affected conflict zones, like Afghanistan, Yemen, Palestine and moving into Sudan and Syria.
